DEFINITION OF SPECIALIZED SERVICES

- A. Specialized services for the treatment of mental illness are those provided by the state through community mental health centers or mental health rehabilitation providers by or under the supervision of a Qualified Mental Health Professional. Such services include:
1. psychiatric, psychological, psycho-social and other evaluations or assessments;
  2. individual, group, family and other professional therapies;
  3. treatment integration and consultation;
  4. psycho-social skills building; and
  5. crisis intervention and support services.
- B. Specialized services for the treatment of mental retardation are those provided by the state by the Office of Mental Retardation or providers under contract to them by or under the supervision of a Qualified Mental Retardation Professional. Such services include:
1. development of skills necessary for activities of daily living;
  2. development of skills necessary for independent living;
  3. development of skills necessary to gain and keep employment;
  4. development of psycho-social skills; and
  5. crisis intervention and support services.
